Following an extensive period of consultation, development and User Acceptance Testing, eAcademy 2.0 and the Volunteer Training Programs will be available from 6 January 2020.

eAcademy 2.0

- eAcademy 2.0 has been designed especially for Students, with an improved interface, intuitive search function and enhanced user experience.
- Users will be able to view and download training resources, apply for courses and Training Programs/Pathways, look at their own training records and complete online training all on a mobile friendly platform.
- The existing eAcademy will continue to be available for Firefighter Development Program participants and staff/volunteers with training administration roles. e.g. Managers, Training Support Officers, BGU leaders, Course Coordinators and Trainer Assessors.

Volunteer Training Programs

- The new Volunteer Training Programs are Service and role specific.
- It will be easier to access the training you need. Progression along the Training Programs (within a service) is automatic for all programs except the Leadership Programs.
- Streams within each Program provides a response-specific grouping of training. A person can do any course in any stream within the Program (prerequisites may apply).
- These Training Programs will replace the current Volunteer Fire, SES and VMR Training Pathways
- You do not need to do anything. There will be an automatic transition process from the current Pathways to the new training programs.
