New Burn SMART planned burning video series launched

The Department of Fire and Emergency Services' Bushfire Centre of Excellence has released a series of videos to help the community prepare for and conduct a planned burn.

The four-part planned burning series covers the six stages of preparing and conducting a planned burn, as outlined in the Burn SMART Guide.

The videos are a new addition to Burn SMART, a set of resources designed to educate landholders about planned burning, to improve the quality of planned burns on private land.

The resources include:

- Burn SMART - A planned burning guide for small landholders (Burn SMART Guide)
- Burn SMART Checklist
- Burn SMART Leaf moisture method
- Burn SMART Planned burning fact sheet

The videos have been designed to be watched in conjunction with reading the Burn SMART guide to give landholders a visual understanding of all necessary steps.

Volunteers and staff can help their community be better prepared to undertake a planned burn by sharing the Burn SMART resources and include the videos in engagement and education activities.
