The conference program features some exciting changes this year. A greater range of site tours and workshops will be available for all delegates to attend. The official opening will be held on Friday afternoon, prior to the Welcome Sundowner. Volunteer Association Annual General Meetings will be held on Sunday morning to provide more opportunity for exciting keynote speakers, plenary sessions and service specific sessions in the Saturday program. The Fire and Emergency Services Awards Gala Dinner will be held on Saturday night.

I am delighted to advise this year there will be more places for volunteers to attend the conference and awards than ever before. Volunteer services will continue to be allocated places, however, an additional 150 places will also be allocated via a ballot system.
