EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST OPEN – FIRELINE LEADERSHIP AND INCIDENT LEADERSHIP COURSES

Expressions of Interest (EOI) are open to DFES staff and VFRS, VFES and BFS volunteers for the following courses, offered in partnership with the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions:

- *Incident Leadership* 23 May – 27 May 2022 (12 places)
- *Incident Leadership* 30 May – 3 June 2022 (12 places)
- *Fireline Leadership* 7 June – 10 June 2022 (12 places)
- *Fireline Leadership* 13 June – 16 June 2022 (12 places)

Fireline Leadership is a course that focuses on helping emergency response leaders build more cohesive, adaptive, and resilient teams. The program includes a mix of theory, case studies, classroom exercises and field exercises designed to reinforce mission-driven operational culture at the team level.

Incident Leadership offers hands-on experience leading a response during an escalating all-hazards incident. Students take on leadership responsibilities in simulation blocks – lasting 16 hours over five days – mirroring events in an emerging incident. Iterative learning cycles and a variety of perspectives provide students with opportunities to learn, practice, and improve incident management skills and leadership behaviours.

The Bushfire Centre of Excellence will be sponsoring the successful applicants, covering the accommodation, course fees and meals for the duration of the course. Travel expenses, including any additional accommodation required to manage fatigue, will need to be met by the relevant DFES Region.

To apply, complete the attached Expression of Interest form in full, obtain regional endorsement for your application and forward it to BushfireCoE@dfes.wa.gov.au by 4pm 22 April 2022.

The EOIs will be reviewed by the Centre of Excellence and the successful applicants contacted prior to 29 April 2022.
