Emergency Driving Training - Applications Open 10 May 2021

DFES is introducing an exciting new course – Emergency Driving Training (EDT) – to improve the safety of volunteers, staff and the community.

The course will be run from the new Koolinup Emergency Services Centre in Collie and the Collie Motorplex, complimenting 'On Road Driving' training to provide the skills to safely drive under emergency conditions. Where possible vehicles used in EDT will reflect those used by volunteers operationally.

What is involved in the course?

Following successful completion of an online assessment you will head to Collie for two-day practical emergency driving training. Accommodation and refreshments will be provided. The first day covers emergency braking under various conditions and hazard avoidance training. On the second day you will undertake a drive navigating through a challenging obstacle course with tight turns and a circuit drive through simulated on road emergency driving scenarios.

Attaining EDT will be compulsory for DFES volunteer pathways to drive under emergency conditions and available for Local Government Bushfire Service (LG BFS) volunteers to complete. Importantly, a five-year transition period is being introduced to allow the time to provide this important training to volunteers who drive under emergency conditions.

A number of progressions to attaining Emergency Driving Training have been identified. As part of this a Recognition of Current Competency program will also be offered to volunteers and staff who can demonstrate operational driving experience. Please refer to the end of this Circular for details.

Finding the course relevant to what is required while driving under emergency conditions, Wayne Jackson, Myalup BFB Fire Control Officer, said this is "definitely a course that every driver of an emergency vehicle needs to attend".

Important Dates and Details

Emergency Driving Training course code is DFES1028.

The first course will be run on the weekend of 3rd and 4th July 2021. Applications open on Monday 10th May 2021 on eAcademy and close 4th June 2021. To apply
