2023 BUSHFIRE OFFICER DEVELOPMENT (BOD 02) – EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

Expressions of interest are called from 16 suitably qualified volunteer firefighters looking to be included in the 2023 Bushfire Officer Development (BOD).

This live-in course will provide an understanding of various rural fire subjects including abridged versions of Fire Weather, Fire Control Officer, Assist with Planned Burning, and Machine Supervision.

The week-long course will cover personnel management and leadership mentoring to assist current serving Brigade Officers in conducting their operational and administrative duties.

ESSENTIAL PREREQUISITES:

- Active member of a BFB/VFES/VFRS Brigade;
- 5 years of operational experience;
- Level 1 Incident Controller endorsement;
- CBFCO/LG/CESM endorsement and/or:
- Regional endorsement (AO/DO/SUPT)

KEY INFORMATION:

This live-in course will take place from Wednesday, 13 September 2023 to Sunday 17 September 2023 at the Bushfire Centre of Excellence, supported by field-based exercises. The Bushfire Centre of Excellence will cover all costs associated with transport, accommodation, and meals.

This practical, hands-on program has been designed to support volunteers undertaking operational leadership positions within their brigade, however, an opportunity to customise aspects of the course based on end-user needs exists.
