DFES Disc Cutting Tools – Cutting Disc Expiry Dates

## **Key Message**


The Cut Off Discs for the Makita cordless Disc Cutter and Chicago Pneumatic Disc Cutter have a 3-year lifespan.

### What happened?

Prior to 2022, the Organisation for Safety of Abrasives (OSA) standards stated that the date stamped on resin-bonded tools marked with the OSA or EN Standard was a validity date.

In September 2022, this wording was changed to an expiry date and includes thin wheels, cut-off and grinding wheels for hand-held machines.

### The expiry date must not exceed more than 3 years after the date of manufacture.



# What does it mean for me?

All Brigades and Units holding the Makita cordless Disc Cutter and Chicago Pneumatic Disc Cutter (Heavy Rescue Stations) must inspect their current stock and dispose of any Cut Off Discs that are past the expiry date.
