DFES CODE OF CONDUCT PROTECTION FOR ALL DFES EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS

The Code of Conduct prescribes mandatory standards of behaviour, conduct and integrity expected of all DFES members, whether employees or volunteers.

The Code of Conduct places an obligation on all DFES members to take responsibility for their behaviour, conduct and integrity; to work cooperatively with each other and the community, establishing a safe and healthy workplace and culture.

DFES has mandatory, online Code of Conduct training for both DFES employees and DFES volunteers. The online course is available on DFES's eAcademy.
