UPDATE TO ARREST OF ALLEGED DFES IMPERSONATOR

Earlier this week WA Police charged a 60-year-old man following an investigation into a person impersonating a Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES) Officer.

According to our records, no one with the name of the man charged has ever worked for or been a volunteer with DFES.

Police will allege that on 14 January 2025 the man attended a truck stop in Kewdale wearing personal protective clothing and helmet with a DFES badge.

It will also be alleged the man was driving a vehicle marked with reflective signage and stickers consistent with those on a DFES vehicle.

He was not in possession of a DFES uniform.
