VOLUNTEER EMPLOYER RECOGNITION AWARD RECIPIENTS ANNOUNCED

More than 80 businesses have been honoured for their outstanding support of WA's emergency services at the 2024 Volunteer Employer Recognition Awards (VERA).

The awards recognise employers that go above and beyond to support staff in responding to incidents during work hours.

Since launching in 2009, VERA has recognised more than 1100 businesses.

This year's deserving recipients come from a range of industries including hospitality, retail and resources and are based right across the State, from Kununurra to Albany.

Of the 82 recipients, 17 are self-employed volunteers who often sacrifice their own earnings or pass up jobs at a moment's notice to respond to emergencies.

Flexible and supportive working arrangements are particularly vital in remote areas, where volunteers are the backbone of our response. It's great to see more than half of the VERA recipients for 2024 are based in regional WA.

Shire of Mundaring and Shire of Narrogin will this year receive Distinctions for Outstanding Support, acknowledging a combined 30 years of unwavering commitment to community safety.
