2024 BUSHFIRE OFFICER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (BOD 03) – EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

Expressions of interest are called for 16 suitably qualified volunteer firefighters looking to be included in the 2024 Bushfire Officer Development program (BOD).

This live-in program will provide participating students an understanding of various rural fire subjects including abridged versions of Fire Weather, Fire Control Officer and Machine Supervision.

The week-long program will cover off on personnel management, leadership, conflict management and difficult conversations in an environment that supports peer-to-peer mentoring to assist both current and aspiring Bushfire Officers in conducting their operational and administrative duties.

- Active member of a BFB/VFES/VFRS Brigade
- 5 years operational experience
- Level 1 Incident Controller endorsement
- CBFCO/LG endorsement (if applicable)
- Regional endorsement (CESM/AO/DO/SUPT)

KEY INFORMATION:

This live-in program will occur from Wednesday, 9 October 2024 to Sunday 13 October 2024 at the Bushfire Centre of Excellence and will include field-based exercises. The Bushfire Centre of Excellence will cover all costs associated with transport, accommodation, and meals.

This practical, hands-on program has been designed to support and develop our members in undertaking operational leadership positions within their brigade, however an opportunity to customise aspects of the course based on end-user needs exists.
