FIREFIGHTERS WANTED: VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES AS JAFFA SUPPORT OFFICERS

Key Message

The Juvenile and Family Fire Awareness (JAFFA) Program is looking for career and volunteer firefighters who are interested in becoming JAFFA Support Officers, to deliver fire safety education to young people involved in playing with or lighting fires. If you are passionate about fire safety and enjoy working with young people, this could be a perfect fit for you!

Applications for JAFFA Support Officers close at 10:00hrs Tuesday 30 April 2024.

What happened?

Are you an operational firefighter passionate about fire safety and dedicated to making a difference in your community?

Do you have experience talking to kids and teens?

Do you have a few spare hours a month to volunteer, especially over the high threat bushfire period?

If this sounds like you then we'd love you to join the JAFFA Program as a JAFFA Support Officer.

We are especially keen for you to join JAFFA if you live in the South East and South Coastal Metropolitan regions, or the Pilbara towns of Karratha and Port Hedland.

Your role as a JAFFA Support Officer includes:

- Contacting families to arrange education sessions.
- Teaching fire safety to kids aged 6 to 16 who have played with fire. You might do this at their home, school, or at the Youth Justice Service.
- Keeping notes during meetings with kids and families and writing detailed reports.
- Collaborating with kids, their families, other groups, and the program leader to make the JAFFA Program work.

All training will be provided and experienced JAFFA Support Officers are available to assist you start this role. Plus, you will feel good knowing you are helping kids and families learn about the risks of playing with fire.
