Mobile Incident Control Centre

Key Message

The Mobile Incident Control Centre (MICC) project is progressing well. Four units are complete and available for incident response, training and exercises. Additional units are scheduled to be delivered in 2025.

What's been happening?

The focus during the MICC development has been on improving ergonomics, interior layout, and user comfort while ensuring that they are simple and userfriendly for personnel to operate.

The MICC has been designed to be highly flexible. It can operate as stand-alone facility, be deployed in multiples to augment a designated Incident Control

Centre or integrate with existing cache infrastructure used by other agencies such as the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions.

Each unit is equipped with.

- Wi-Fi connectivity via 4G (Telstra and Optus) and Starlink for remote areas
- Monitors with USB-C passthrough, enabling bring-your-own-device (BYOD) operation
- Printing and Copying capability
- Air conditioning

What does it mean for me?

For incident deployments, Incident Controllers can request the MICC through the MOC/ROC for the relevant Assistant Commissioner's approval. Once approved, activation will be coordinated through the State Operations Logistics.

For deployment for training exercises, etc., contact State Operations Logistics Manager Lyndon Jackson. The requester is responsible for all associated transportation costs.
