Metropolitan Mid-band Radio Replacement Project

Key Message

DFES is upgrading radio communication systems in Metropolitan fire appliances to enhance our capabilities and ensure reliable equipment for years to come, starting 19th August.

What happened? / What's been happening?

Our current mid-band radios are outdated, and we are replacing them with new hi-band single body radios. Existing WAERN radios will have some re-programming at the same time.

What does it mean for me? / What do I need to do?

- Check the new Pre-formed Communications Plans that will be published 16th August and understand any changes in your region
- Upgrades will commence Monday 19th August, and continue until the 31st October.
- Look for communications in the future about when your BGU will be updated.
