#### STATE AERIAL FIREFIGHTING AIRCRAFT START DATES

### **Key Message**

Seasonal aerial firefighting aircraft have commenced operations for the 2024/2025 southern bush fire season.

## What's happening?

Aerial firefighting resources are being brought online in a staggered manner. Known start dates are listed overleaf. Dates listed as TBA are dependent upon seasonal conditions and will be announced when known.

#### What does it mean for me?

Operational personnel should familiarise themselves with relevant aspects of aerial firefighting such as fireground safety, Ground Controller functions, and request/mobilisation procedures for aerial firefighting aircraft.
